Subject- Refund Drive beginning from 01st September 2019 to 22nd September 2019 - Reg.

It has been decided by the Ministry of Finance, CBIC to organize a refund drive commencing from 01st September 2019 to 22nd September 2019. The officers and staff would attend to all the issues pertaining to refunds. During this period the offices shall remain open on Saturday also.

2. All the constituent members of Trade Associations/ Chamber of Commerce and Industry/Members of Regional Advisory Committee/Public grievance Committee are requested to circulate and publicize the contents of this Public Notice amongst their member constituents.

3. The exclusive camps /refund cell has been set up at all the divisions of this Commissionerate to deal with cases of pending refund claims from 01st September 2019 to 22nd September 2019. All taxpayers are advised to contact the following nodal officers of the concerned divisions of their jurisdiction to resolve their issues related to refund claims.

Sub: Observation of a refund drive from 1st September to 22nd September, 2019 - reg.

During a press conference on 23.08.2019 on measures to achieve higher economic growth, the Hon'ble FM announced that **all pending GST refunds due to MSMEs shall be paid within 30 days and that all future GST refunds shall be paid within 60 days from the date of application.** This was also discussed during the last video conference held on 26.08.2019.

2. Accordingly, it has been decided to organize a refund drive throughout the country to successfully implement the Hon'ble FM's announcement. The focus of the refund drive should be on disposing refunds of MSMEs, but other claims should also be disposed within 30 days.
3. Therefore, the undersigned is directed to instruct you to organize a refund drive in your Zone from 1st to 22nd September, 2019. The objective to be achieved during the drive are the following:
 - a. A nodal officer of the rank of Joint/Additional Commissioner in the Principal Chief Commissioner/Chief Commissioner's Office should be designated to coordinate with the CGST Commissionerates and the State tax authorities
 - b. All refund claims submitted/received in **FORM GST RFD-01A** on or before 23.08.2019 to be disposed by 22.09.2019
 - c. Special attention to be paid to refund claims submitted by MSMEs, i.e. those applicants whose annual aggregate turnover in the preceding financial year did not exceed Rs. 2 crores

In this regard, a weekly report in the **enclosed format** shall be sent by email to dggst-chic@gov.in with a copy to gst-cbec@gov.in.

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4. In relation to the payment of all future GST refunds within 60 days from the date of application, attention is invited to para 5 of Circular No. 79/53/2018-GST dated 31.12.2018 wherein it has been clarified that any tax shall be considered to have been refunded only when the amount has been credited to the bank account of the claimant. Accordingly, the proper officers shall issue the final sanction orders in **FORM GST RFD-06** within 45 days of the date of generation of ARN, so that the disbursement is completed within 60 days by both Central and State Tax Authorities for CGST / IGST / UTGST / Compensation Cess and SGST respectively. Further, attention is invited to Member (GST) D.O. letter dated 14.08.2019 urging all field formation to ensure that the details of the refund orders are uploaded on the system in **FORM GST RFD-01B**. This may be ensured especially during the refund drive.

5. Wide publicity may be given to the refund drive and the trade and industry associations engaged to make the endeavour a grand success.

6. This issues with the approval of Chairman, CBIC.
