



With reference to subject matter, it is reiterated that vide above CBEC circular, certain procedure has been issued for clearance of imported metal scrap (both ferrous and non-ferrous). This has been issued in continuation of DGFT Public Notice no. 38/ (2015-2020) dated 06-10-2016

During course of interacting with Trade for attracting more business at ICD/Ratlam, interest have been evinced towards bringing Import Containers of Metal scrap as same is expected to reduce their logistics cost besides enhancing their convenience due to their establishment being in vicinity of ICD/Ratlam

As you are well aware that Import volumes have already come down at ICD and both CONCOR & Customs need to take steps for its revival. An increase in imports would facilitate availability of empty Containers which in turn will make Containers available to export customers for outward movement. With such an intention, it is desirable that advantage is taken of policy guidelines issued vide Circular under reference

In view of above, it is requested to give your formal go ahead so that marketing efforts can be given an impetus and deliberations with potential Scrap importers customers be taken to a logical conclusion in the interest of both CONCOR & Customs
